LEXICAL ITEM	MEANING	EXAMPLE
1- <i>To morph</i>	To ridicule; to mock	<i>The river flooded its banks and <u>morphed</u> into a giant sea that swamped the town.</i>
2- <i>Stripped-down</i>	The use of something or someone in an effective way. The spreading out, utilization, or arrangement for a deliberate purpose.	
3- <i>To poke (fun at)</i>	To become fashionable or popular.	
4- <i>Anglicize</i>	Causing or likely to cause disagreement.	
5- <i>Deployment</i>	To change one image into another, or combine them, using a computer program to change the form or character. To develop a new appearance or change into something else, or to make something do this.	
6- <i>Decaffeinated</i>	To make or become	

	<p>English in sound, appearance or character. To make English in quality or characteristics. To adapt (a foreign word, name, or phrase) to English usage.</p>	
<p>7- To catch (on)</p>	<p>Having the caffeine removed. Describes coffee or tea from which the caffeine (= a chemical substance) has been removed.</p>	
<p>8- To splash out</p>	<p>To spend a lot of money on buying things, especially things which are pleasant to have but which you do not need.</p>	
<p>9- Contentious</p>	<p>To act in order to make sth.happen sooner.</p>	
<p>10- To hasten</p>	<p>Lacking any extra features. Reduced to its simplest form.</p>
